

SKILLS INVENTORY

In making determinations about where teams should be assigned for mission projects, it is helpful for us to know interests, skills and gifts of the participants. In most cases, the youth leader and the missions representative have discussed which projects are most appropriate. The following information will help us in completing the process. Your group will be divided into teams of 8-12 persons for home repair, construction and grounds projects. There will need to be at least one adult leader from your group for each team. The Timothy Project makes sure all teams are assigned properly and materials are at the ready. Those involved in carpentry, plumbing and other technical skills should bring tools with them. Each group will be responsible for supervising its own work.
