Thank you so much for your participation in mission work through *Jericho Road, LLC operating as The Timothy Project*.

Your desire to be the presence of Christ to those in need mirrors the life of Timothy in the New Testament. He was a young person who chose the life of service to Jesus Christ in assisting the Apostle Paul in his ministry.

There are principles we want to follow as we minister with others in Christ's name:

- 1) **Missions is incarnational.** We function as the hands and feet, hearts and minds of Jesus in the work we do.
- 2) **Missions is relational.** This is an opportunity to strengthen and develop relationships, between you and your group, you and those you minister to and to God. Take the time to connect.
- 3) **Missions is mutual.** We must remember that all of us are equal in the sight of God. It is good to have the attitude that I am helping a friend or loved one in an attempt to make that person real to you.

You will be engaged in a variety of work projects. No project will put you in a position of danger. However, working with tools and doing physical work does carry with it some degree of risk. Your safety is of highest importance at all times. The only power tools used will be weed trimmers, electric shears, and lawnmowers. Safety glasses are required when operating equipment. Any use of other power tools must be supervised by an adult leader from your group who accepts responsibility for that use. We suggest following the policy set by Habitat for Humanity that requires those using power equipment to be 16 years of age or older. We will follow the policy of assigning use of power equipment to those authorized by your adult leader.

There may be occasion for you to ride in vehicles operated by staff of The Timothy Project. An adult leader should be present on any such occasion. If any sort of medical problem should arise, your youth director or an adult counselor will be present to assist you in ways stipulated in your church's own consent form.

Lastly, although we have high expectations of you and your group, we feel it important to emphasize and agree to conform to these rules of conduct:

- No possession or use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco
- No offensive or immodest clothing
- Respect of property
- Respect of group members, staff, adult leaders and ministry recipients
- Willingness to follow a schedule
